1ST DAY – Porto

17h00 – Arrival at Douro Marina for check in

You may use the time to go shopping and visit Porto.

We suggest you go dinner at local Restaurant “Armazém do Peixe” at a 5 minute walk from our marina.

2ND DAY – Porto / Caldas de Aregos

09h10 – Departure from Douro Marina

11h10 – Lock of Crestuma

16h40 – Lock of Carrapatelo

Arrival at Caldas de Aregos

We suggest lunch at Jardim do Arda Restaurant or a pic-nic at Ilha dos Amores (Lovers Island)

There are a couple of nice local restaurants at Caldas de Aregos for dinner such as Restaurante das Caldas

3RD DAY – Caldas de Aregos – Pinhão

10h00 – Departure from Caldas de Aregos

17h30 – Lock of Régua

We recommend a stop at Régua and have lunch at the Restaurant Tasca da Quinta. At Régua you can also visit the Museu do Douro or have lunch at Quinta da Pacheca.

Arrival at Pinhão

4th Day – Pinhão / Foz do Sabor

12h00: Departure from Pinhão

14h10: Lock of Valeira

Arrival at Foz do Sabor

After leaving Pinhão you will cross the fourth lock – Valeira. Before the lock you have “Estreito da Valeira” or strait of Valeira where the river is narrow with some considerable flow and after the lock, you have “Cachão da Valeira” – a large and calm area surrounded by enormous Rocky Mountains. It is famous for the location where Baron Forrester’s died (a prominent figure of Port wine history) because in the past it was a very dangerous part

of the river and many people died sailing there. Lunch in a local restaurant in Ferradosa or Senhora da Ribeira. Departure towards Foz do Sabor where you will spend the night. We suggest you visit the historical Village of Torre de Moncorvo and have dinner there in the Restaurant Lagar (+351 279 252 828).

5th Day – Foz do Sabor / Pinhão

11h00: Departure from Foz do Sabor

13h45: Lock of Valeira

Arrival at Pinhão

A transfer could take you to Casa de Mateus, a manor-house from the XVIII century, considered the Portuguese most beautiful and emblematic baroque building.

Also possible is to visit one of the Wine Estates in this region. An example is Quinta do Bomfim, located in Pinhão at a walking distance from our pier, where you can visit the family vineyards and taste the famous Port Wine

6th DAY – Pinhão – Caldas de Aregos

09h45 – Departure towards Caldas de Aregos

11h30 – Lock Régua

12h30 – Stop at Régua to visit the Museu do Douro. You can also have lunch at Quinta da Pacheca.

Arrival at Caldas de Aregos

7th DAY - Caldas de Aregos – Porto

09h25 – Departure from Caldas de Aregos

10h25 – Lock of Carrapatelo

14h55 – Lock of Crestuma

Arrival at Douro Marina and check-out proceedings (you will stay on the boat one more night)
